

GRINDLEFORD COMMUNITY SUPPORT NETWORK – HOW IT WORKS

STREET WARDENS

The street warden network covers the whole village. They have made themselves known to the people living in their patch and handed over information sheets about available services – shopping, prescriptions and careline calls - to those in vulnerable groups. They have provided their contact details, are taking care of individuals and will help anyone in need of it.

The street wardens can access all the services on behalf of their residents. All except the careline calls can be accessed directly.

PRESCRIPTIONS SERVICE
